## *High Point Awards*

### Qualifying Criteria Document

*Updated October 2017*

In order to qualify for the AEVA High Point Awards, candidates must meet the below outlined criteria.

- The AEVA High Point Awards are awarded annually at the Annual General Meeting and/or the Awards Banquet hosted by the Alberta Equestrian Vaulting Association.
- High Point Awards will be awarded in each recognized Individual Division by gender, Pas De Deux and Squads. Please see the chart below of divisions that will be awarded.
- Only scores obtained at recognized competitions will count towards determining the winners of the High Point Awards. Competitions sanctioned by Equestrian Canada, or FEI level competitions (CVIs) will be considered recognized competitions. Scores obtained at CVIs must be in the equivalent level of the scores obtained at National or Provincial level competitions to count towards the High Point Awards. Please refer to the chart below for EC and FEI equivalent divisions. Scores from clinic classes or schooling shows do not count towards the High Point Awards.
- If the Individual, Pas De Deux or Squad has competed at least twice in a single Division during one calendar year, the two scores will be used to calculate the average score achieved. Scores for Pas De Deux will only count if the same two vaulters have competed as a pair at both events.
- If the Individual, Pas De Deux or Squad has competed more than twice in a single Division during the calendar year, the highest two scores obtained will be used to calculate the average score achieved.
- A ranking list of all the Individual, Pas De Deux and Squads in each Division will be distributed to all the coaches at the end of the season.
- If an Individual, Pas De Deux or Squad has competed in more than one Division during one calendar year, and has achieved the highest average score in both Divisions, the Individual, Pas De Deux or Squad will only be awarded the High Point Award in the higher of the two Divisions. For example, a vaulter competed in Division B Walk and Division D Canter and achieved the highest average in both Divisions. The vaulter will be awarded the Division D Canter award, while the Division B Walk award will be awarded to the vaulter with the second highest average score in that Division.
- Only Individual, Pas De Deux or Squad residing in Alberta, holding current AEF and AEVA memberships will be eligible.
