Music and Labelling

- All music is to be submitted on audio formatted compact disk (CD) only.
 - CD-R media should be used as some players have difficulty playing CD-RW media.
 - CDs containing MP3 or other digital music files will not be accepted.
 - Audiocassettes will no longer be accepted.

 - Music for mounted classes must be submitted on one CD and music for barrel classes must be submitted on a separate CD (This is to allow shows to run these classes in parallel, if required).
 - The tracks on the CD for horse classes are to be organized as follows:
 - Track 01: Run In Music
 - Track 02 – nn: Compulsory Music, one track per vaulter or one track per class (see below*) in the order of go**.
 - Track nn+1 (and greater): Freestyle Music, one track per vaulter in order of go**.
 - The tracks on the CD for barrel classes are to be organized as follows:
 - Track 01 (and greater): Freestyle Music, one track per vaulter in order of go**.
 - The use of run in music and music in compulsories is not required under the Alberta Equestrian Vaulting Association rules.
- ** It is strongly recommended that each club makes extra copies of any CDs that they submit so that there are ready replacements if a CD should become damaged. ***

*For compulsories, the club has the choice of providing one music selection per vaulter, or one music selection for the club per class. This choice is available on a class-by-class basis (e.g. individual music could be provided for vaulters registered in canter C and a single selection for vaulters in Walk B). For any given class, only one option is permitted. Where a club uses a single track for a class, the selected music shall be long enough to accommodate all the vaulters inclusive of a small delay between each.

**The order of vaulters on the CD must be grouped per class, and within each class must be in the same order the vaulters appeared on the class registration form. This will ensure that the tracks appear in the same order as the competitors in the published order of go / show program. Clubs must provide as few CDs as possible. Generally, if music is shortened to the required time allowed, one CD for horse and one for barrel should be sufficient for an entire club.

It is permissible to split a club across more than one CD only when there are more music selections required than would fit on a single CD. When splitting the music between CDs, all of a club's entrants per class must be contained on a single CD.

- Each CD shall be clearly labelled as follows:
 - Club Name (e.g. "Mt. Arrowsmith")
 - Class Type – "Mounted Classes" or "Barrel Classes"

- 02 – Comp – Walk D – All
- 03 – Comp – Walk C – Mary Jones
- 04 – Comp – Walk C – Susan Brown
- 05 – Freestyle – Walk D – Jane Smith
- 06 – Freestyle – Walk D – Kim White
- 07 – Freestyle – Walk C – Mary Jones
- 08 – Freestyle – Walk C – Susan Brown

Instructions for filling in the On-Line Entry Forms

- One *Entry Summary on-line Worksheet* is to be completed per club.
- Use on-line forms provided for Individual Classes, Pairs Classes, and Team Classes.
- List all entries for a given class in a continuous block (e.g. list all canter D, then all canter C, then all canter B, etc.)
- **Within a class, put entries in the preferred order of go.**
- Please take note of the time limits and other specifics for the various classes (particularly the barrel classes).
- Each vaulter, coach and lunger must complete, sign and return a release/waiver form. Participation will not be permitted without a properly completed and signed form.
- Vaulters from Alberta must have valid memberships of the Alberta Equestrian Federation and the Alberta Equestrian Vaulting Association at the time of registration in the event. It is the responsibility of the clubs/coaches to ensure these memberships are in good standing prior to submitting the registration package.
- Please ensure that each vaulter is eligible for the selected class(es). Note also that for events that include two rounds, the combined average score for both rounds is used to determine eligibility to enter AEVA classes in future AEVA recognized events.
- **Important:** Ensure that **all entries and waivers** are complete and, along with **full payment**, are received by: Melanie O'Neill, for the Alberta Equestrian Vaulting Association, on or before the entry deadline: [March 22, 2010](#). All cheques are to be made payable to the [Alberta Equestrian Vaulting Association](#).
- There will be no refunds for any scratches.**
- Please take note that all submitted music is organized on a CD and labelled correctly. Please see topic about Music and Labelling.
